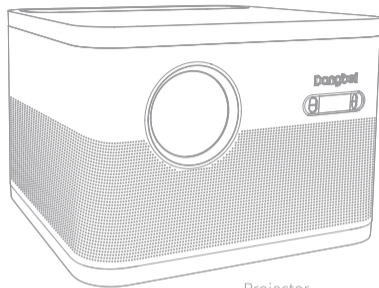
Thank you for choosing the DangBei Smart projector. Before using the device, please read this quick start guide carefully and keep it properly for future use.

Safety Information

- The use of unreliable electrical cables can affect the performance and characteristics of the device. Also, this may result in electric shock, fire, or other accidents. To avoid the above situations, we recommend using original electrical cables.
- During a lightning or if the device is not used for a long time, please turn off and remove the plug from the outlet. This way, you can avoid damage to the projector, which can occur due to lightning or overvoltage of power lines.
- Do not leave flammable objects near the device to avoid a fire.
- Do not cover the lens with objects while it is operating to avoid lens heating, deformation, and even fire.
- Do not leave objects near the ventilation openings and air circulation holes.
- Do not install the units on an unstable surface, tables to avoid falling or injuring others.
- Do not look directly into the lens or into the air circulation holes during operation to avoid eye injuries.
- Do not put the device:
 1. In a damp environment.
 2. Places with poor ventilation or air circulation and high temperature over 40degree.
 3. In direct sunlight.

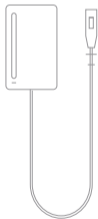

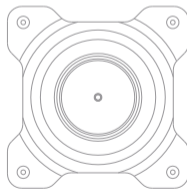

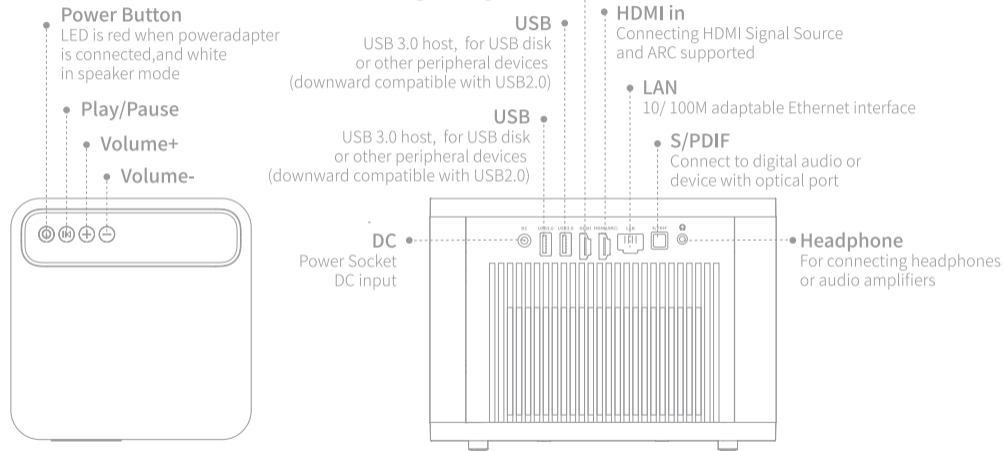

Keys and Interface Description.



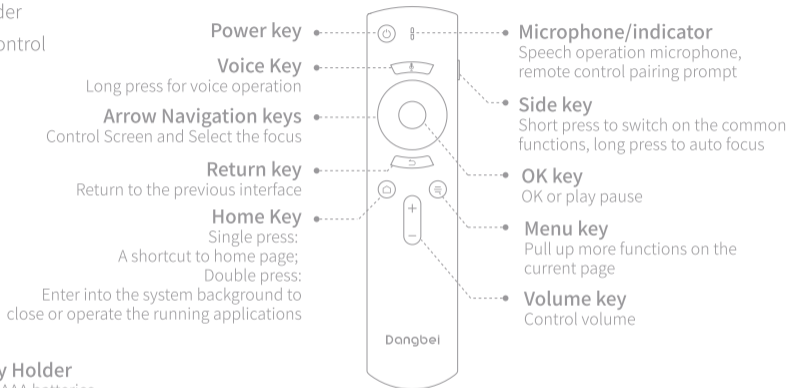
* Accessories include a bracket adapter tray. If you need to use the mount bracket, please buy one.

Remote Control

1. Open the battery holder cover of the remote control
2. Install 2 AAA batteries
3. Put back the cover

Install 2 AAA batteries

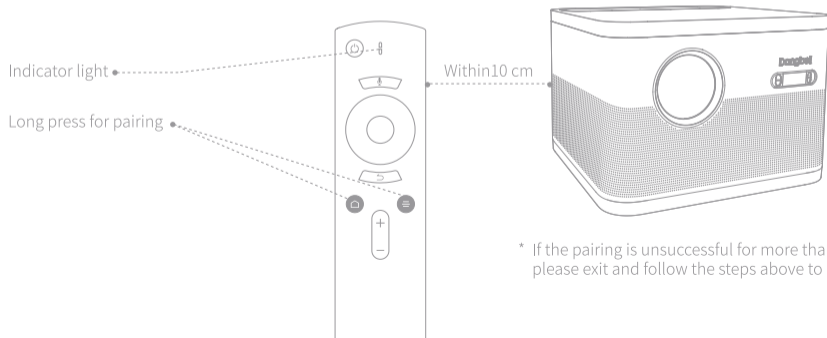


* Standard in the package, please install the battery in correct direction.

Remote Control Pairing

- 1.Wait for the Bluetooth pairing prompt to appear on the screen after power on.
- 2.Make sure remote control close to the device within 10cm.
Meanwhile press and hold the  and  key simultaneously.
- 3.The remote controller indicator shows flashing red light means the pairing connection is successful.
Wait for seconds and release the keys after you see the indicator stop flashing.

Connect to a Wi-Fi network

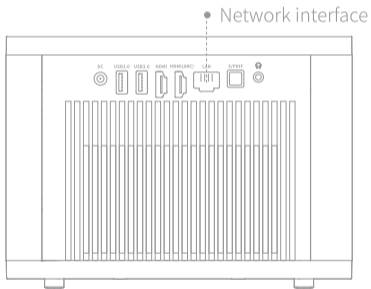
1. Go to [Settings] and select [Network Settings]

[Focus Setting] to focus.

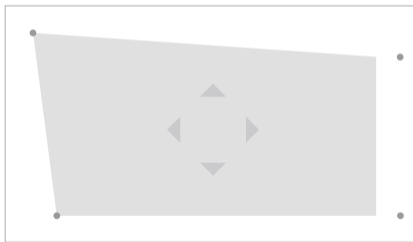


* When focusing manually, user can adjust the picture sharpness by using the up and down keys of the remote control.

to correct.

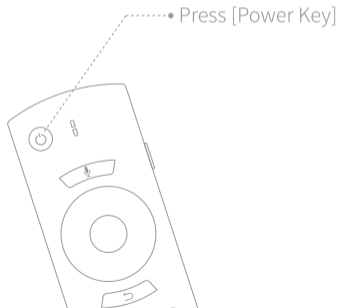


* While using Manual Keystone Correction, press "OK" Key to select the point, and adjust the correction position by the arrow keys
